407 kph or 253 mph



The strongest gust ever recorded was in 1996 in Barrow Island, Australia when Tropical Cyclone Olivia produced an extremely powerful three-second gust of 253 mph, according to the University of Arizona.

For a person who weighs 100 pounds (45.3 kilograms), it would take a wind speed of:

40 to 45 mph or approx 60 kph to 70 kph, or tropical storm force, to knock them over.

At 407 kph you'd be flying!!!!!!!!
